

# Sale Of Notes For Tiger Tractor Co. Looks Successful

Although the latest figures are not available today, leaders in the campaign to sell \$40,000 in notes to construct a new factory building for Tiger Tractor Co. are confident of the drive's success.

Representatives of Keyser's four service clubs are canvassing the community in the final phase of the drive, which closes Dec. 7. A special committee of the Keyser-Mineral County Chamber of Commerce reported Saturday that more than \$30,000 of the notes had already been sold.

Deer season has caused a slight lag in the campaign, because so many local merchants and businessmen are hunting. It is thought a fairly accurate report on the campaign will be available tomorrow, with the closing of deer season this evening.

The \$40,000 raised through the sale of notes, plus \$10,000 raised by Tiger Tractor, will finance the construction of a concrete block building 60 by 120 feet on a lot between F and G Sts. adjacent to the Baltimore and Ohio Railroad.

Persons who wish to purchase the \$100 notes, bearing five per cent interest, may do so at either of Keyser's two banks.
